

Administration Training and Data Workshop

This five-hour, on-site training is a walk-through of everything needed to know to administer the CalSCHLS surveys and to use the CalSCHLS data for LCAP, MTSS, and school climate improvement.

During the two-hour **Administration Training** participants will learn:

- » Steps for registration
- » Procedures for administration
- » Strategies for improving participation
- » How to use the **new** online CalSCHLS Data Dashboard (<https://calschls.org/reports-data/dashboard/>) to examine secondary district data, including:
 - Trends over time on indicators of
 - school climate such as school connectedness and safety,
 - student mental health,
 - school engagement and supports, and
 - student substance use.
 - Disparities in survey outcomes across:
 - gender, race/ethnicity,
 - English language proficiency (self-report),
 - free/reduced-price meal eligibility (self-report),
 - foster and homeless youth, and
 - other student subgroups.

During the three-hour **Data Workshop** participants will bring copies of their most recent CHKS, CSSS, and CSPS reports to examine key indicators for:

- The Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and CA School Dashboard local priorities:
 - Priority 6, School Climate (school connectedness and safety)
 - Priority 3, Parent involvement
 - Priority 1, Facilities
- The implementation of Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) such as PBIS
- Student social, emotional and mental health
- Student alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use
- Disparities in survey outcomes across race/ethnicity

This combination training and workshop is offered at the CDE supported rate of \$125/hour for travel time plus travel costs.
