



Data Workshop

This on-site, three-hour Data Workshop is designed to engage district and school staff in examining their student (CHKS), staff (CSSS), and parent (CSPS) CalSCHLS data.

The costs of the Workshop is determined by the California Department of Education and for the 2019-2020 school year those costs are \$125 per hour for preparation, presentation, and travel time plus travel expenses such as mileage, parking, taxi, airfare, lodging, and per diem (for meals) as applicable.
