The Biennial Survey

Description

The Biennial California Healthy Kids Survey is offered to randomly selected schools every two years. Data from this representative state survey provide the norms for comparison with district CHKS results and have contributed to a better understanding of how to address the state's needs regarding school climate and safety, pupil engagement, academic performance, and overall student well-being.

Next Steps

To take advantage of this opportunity, you must be part of the randomly selected sample. You may contact your TA to inquire, or they will reach out to districts that have been selected.

Behavioral Health Module

Description

A multiform survey module that assesses secondary student well-being indicators (i.e., social isolation, body image and disordered eating, responses to trauma (PTSD symptoms), precursors to and consequences of substance use) and protective factors (i.e., home adult supports, peer supports, and school mental health supports).
